The Lord has done great things for us, and we are filled with joy. (Psalm 126:3)

or more than 45 years, our mission at Walk Thru the Bible has been helping people everywhere live God's Word. We work to make the Bible not just accessible for people, but also applicable and understandable. We want to help people to not just have knowledge of the Bible, to not just read it occasionally or to only hear it in church or Bible study once a week, but to help them truly engage with Scripture and apply it to their lives. Daily.

At Walk Thru the Bible, we know the Bible changes everything--changes hearts, changes lives, changes families, and most importantly, changes eternities. We work to make Kingdom impact, through our live events and biblical resources. We help people experience life transformation through engaging with the Word of God in memorable, innovative ways.

And because we know the Bible changes everything, we want people to dive deep into Scripture, to immerse themselves in God's Story--after all, it's their story too! And we want to create global Bible movements.

In late 2018, God had been stirring my heart and spirit with a restlessness about the now-and-future direction of Walk Thru the Bible. He gave me the freedom to dream again about Walk Thru's global impact. He inspired me to a fresh, big-picture vision of Walk Thru's direction. Not a different mission for Walk Thru, but a larger footprint for this ministry to ignite passion for God's Word around the world. It was as if He said to my heart, "I am doing a new thing," just as He told the children of Israel in the book of Isaiah. And He was simultaneously working in the hearts of others about this same vision.

That vision was to double our global ministry impact in three years.

We launched this vision on July 1, 2019.

So what did this mean practically? For fiscal year 2018-19, Walk Thru the Bible impacted the lives of 1,960,908 people in nearly 130 countries. To double that meant Walk Thru the



Bible would impact 3,921,816 people by fiscal year 2021-22.

Accomplishing the goal centered around 7 growth strategies: Launch a global ministry for kids; leverage technology to expand our ministry reach; establish partnerships that deliver events and resources to new audiences; expand our live event ministry among U.S. churches; increase content creation that encourages Bible engagement globally; develop an intensive, intentional pastor training model; and broaden our ministry for the persecuted church.

Year 1

In year 1, there were many initiatives and items to accomplish and a lot of groundwork to lay. We built new infrastructure—a new website, new structure for our global regions, new initiatives to position us for growth and impact. We prayed, made our plans, and worked. You partnered with us in incredible ways, and we are grateful.

We made significant progress toward the year 1 goals; we were seeing 10% growth through the first 6 months of the fiscal year, with more growth projected as new initiatives launched.

And then the pandemic hit, and as the world locked down, we wondered if we had misunderstood or misheard God—Did He really give us the vision to double global ministry impact in three years? But we knew that we didn't mishear Him. We had too many affirmations of the strategy and direction we were taking.

God wasn't caught by surprise by the pandemic.

At that time, we began to pivot toward digital ministry content and

digital delivery, which was accelerated by COVID-19. We launched *Walk Thru Voices*, the *Daily Walk Podcast*, free live-stream courses including *Step Into the Story OT* (our big picture overview of the Old Testament) and *HomeTeam*, the WTB blog, and more. We also developed virtual training for under-resourced pastors, teaching and training them in our Biblical Character Series courses.

Year 2

Year 2 was a challenging year, full of shutdowns, but miracles, too. We launched a global kids ministry even though schools in many parts of the world were closed. We filmed and distributed *Step Into the Story NT* as a free, live-stream event. We launched *Step Into the Story* Podcast where we

interview guests from diverse walks of life who love God and His Word. We filmed and launched *Refuge: Finding Home in a World of Change* (based on the story of Ruth).

We embraced this new reality of the pandemic and quickly pivoted to minister in new ways. Choosing this path not only allowed Walk Thru to continue to reach people with God's Word, but opened up new doors and opportunities we could have never imagined.

Year 3

Year 3 was the final year of the plan, and our WTB global family continued the great work they had started. Their faithfulness, their love for God and for people, and their heart for and belief in the ministry of Walk Thru really shone through.

We filmed and distributed Jesus in the Old Testament and Bible Study Simplified as free, streaming courses. We developed a WTB mobile application (which is about to launch in 10 languages). We released two new Biblical Character Series courses on the life of Ruth—Refuge: Finding Home in a World of Change—and on the life of Moses—Rescue: Leading Yourself and Others to Freedom. Refuge has been translated and filmed in Russian—to minister to Ukrainian refugees wherever they are—and in Arabic.

As a result of all the prayers, strategizing, and hard work; all of your support and encouragement; and especially, God's guidance and inspiration, Walk Thru the Bible impacted 3,909,042 lives around the world in year 3! That is 99.67% of the goal!

We've seen other areas of transformation and strength within Walk Thru the Bible itself. The ministry is strong financially. The global team and the Atlanta team have become more nimble and forward-thinking. The culture in the whole organization has experienced an exciting shift to new ways of ministering to more people in more places than ever before.

Thank you for walking alongside us every step of the way. There were some difficult days, and you encouraged us at exactly the right time, either with a note, a text, a message, even a gift. That meant the world to us. And we hope you'll join us in celebrating the culmination of Walk Thru the Bible's 3-year goal of doubling our global ministry impact, because "the LORD has done great things for us, and we are filled with joy!"



Ministry in Ukraine

few months ago, Boris Volkov and his family were living a peaceful, beautiful life in Kiev, Ukraine. Boris, Walk Thru the Bible's Regional Director for Northern Eurasia, was working daily with pastors and ministry partners throughout Ukraine to train and resource them to teach people God's Word. Over the past year, he and his team had started teaching Refuge: Find*ing Home in a World of Change*, one of our newest Biblical Character Series courses based on the life of Ruth, Naomi, and Boaz. While Boris liked the material, he was trying to find a way to make it more relevant to the people of Ukraine and Eurasia.

He explains, "For me, the red thread of this course was actually caring for refugees and displaced people. I was thinking to myself, 'There were a number of refugees from the war, from the frontline area, back in 2014 in Ukraine, but it's not that prevalent anymore. So, let's focus on other aspects of displacement, for example, such as in terms of searching for a job or moving for school, displacement because of divorce or the death of a loved one, and more.""

and the Ukrainian people was normal. The concept of encountering a refugee, much less being a refugee, was not one many people would find relatable.

Then came February 24, 2022. The world watched in horror as Russia invaded Ukraine, transforming Boris's peaceful home into a warzone. Like millions of other Ukrainians, Boris and



his family found themselves in the middle of a war, and were forced to leave their home, their neighbors, their friends, all that they knew. Suddenly, Ruth and Naomi's story became his own story—the story of a refugee, the story of a displaced people.

and ultimately grace-filled journey that he and his family have experienced since February. Though he had to leave his home, he did not leave behind God's call on his life to ministry. God immediately began opening up doors for Boris to teach Refuge to displaced Ukrainians across Europe. In fact, he even had the opportunity to translate this study into the Ukrainian people's heart language and record it as a video series—and that Refuge recording was broadcast on satellite TV and made available to people serving in refugee camps, to pastors ministering to people who come through their church doors, and to those ministering on the frontlines. While Boris was initially unsure how much this curriculum would resonate, he now sees that God ordained *Refuge* to reach his people during this exact time. Ukrainians are hearing a lot of messages right now, but he believes the story of Ruth might be the most needed.

As a refugee himself, Boris says, "I would prefer to hear something that warms up my soul, my broken spirit, revitalizes my faith. I don't know where, and I don't know how...but God wants me to find a home in this changing world."

He has seen that other refugees are having the same experience. "I also testify that when I was teaching this course live in refugee camps in Poland and Czechia and Romania, I saw people reflecting on this important curriculum not in the way theologians would, but in the way starving, thirsty souls absorb waters of hope."

Pastor Vadim Chubikin agrees. A long-time partner of Walk Thru the Bible Ukraine, he was the pastor of a prison ministry, but due to the war, his work has changed—the prisons in the region where he served are either in now-occupied regions or the people have been evacuated to safer regions. So Pastor Vadim and his co-ministers are now working with refugees and people in the frontline area.

He is using *Refuge* to minister to refugees by either streaming it for people wherever he is working or incorporating the material into his messages of hope to suffering people. He says that *Refuge* is one of the best tools in his ministry toolbox for these days. "There was not a single sermon that finished without tears on people's cheeks," he says. "It is not my desire to increase their emotions. It is the story of Ruth that speaks directly to their hearts through the *Refuge* course."

"Many people were living a normal life," says Pastor Vadim. They were not rich or poor, but they were selfsufficient, with a home, a job, and food on the table. "But these self-sufficient people became refugees or became impoverished to the point where they needed housing and food assistance," he says. And because people were living their lives, going about their day-to-day, no one expected all of the death and destruction and chaos, or having to flee to safety.

"In all the darkness of these heavy

days," says Pastor Vadim, "God began to write a new history of the church in Ukraine. Evangelical churches are actively involved in various work aimed at helping people in need. They are helping to evacuate people and delivering food and water. And, of course, this is an opportunity to point to the One who has a word of compassion and the words of eternal life," he says.

According to Pastor Vadim, one of the tools that the evangelical churches are using is our Refuge course. "As never before, the story of Ruth, Naomi, and Boaz has become relevant and healing

for so many wounded hearts," he says. He shares how the people eagerly absorb these words of hope when churches minister to and support the people in the frontline areas and the cities where refugees live. Churches are seeing more and more people coming to their services that have not been to church before.

"While for many people the trajectory of life is still going down, a look from God's perspective gives hope that our good God, our Savior and Redeemer, wants to bring the wanderer to their true Home," says Pastor Vadim.

When Walk Thru the Bible develops a new course, whether it's in the Biblical Character Series or some other series, we have no idea how or where God will use it. But we hear story after story of where our courses have gone—to teach prisoners in a prison in Alabama; to teach public school children in Nigeria; to teach police officers

Essentially, life for Boris and his family Boris shares the painful, harrowing,

in Manila; to teach college students in Johannesburg; and so much more. "Who knew that two years ago, when our team in Atlanta was developing *Refuge*, that it would connect so perfectly with so many Ukrainian people who now find themselves displaced?" says Phil Tuttle, Walk Thru the Bible's president. "And who knew this new resource would bring hope to so many refugees both inside and outside Ukraine as well as clearly presenting the Gospel to help them find their eternal home? And who knew this resource would be used by pastors and church leaders and church members in other Eastern European countries to minister to Ukrainian refugees who have migrated to their countries? We sure didn't know, but God did."

And God is bringing hope to people in this war-torn country through Walk Thru the Bible.

t Walk Thru the Bible. we help people everywhere live God's Word. Every day, we serve the biblically unengaged through our innovative live events and our biblical resources-from otLIVE to the Biblical Character Series studies, from ntLIVE to the Bible Study Simplified streaming series, Step Into the Story Podcast to Walk Thru Voices. Every day, we serve the persecuted church through our biblical resources that are used by individuals in secret churches, home groups, and more. And every day, we minister to under-resourced pastors around the world by equipping them with our biblical tools and providing training and community for them.

Our mission is to help people deeply engage with Scripture, to understand it and apply it their lives, to study its pages every day, to know why it's important. Our mission is to make the Bible more than accessible; instead, to make it understandable and applicable, to help people discover the beauty and wonder and joy in its pages. And our mission is to help people discover and explore the depths of meaning in God's Word.

We want the Bible to impact lives for God's Kingdom.

On July 1, 2019, we launched a 3-year vision to double Walk Thru the Bible's global ministry impact in 3 years. By June 30, 2022, this meant Walk Thru the Bible would impact 3,921,816 lives each year around the world. As you read in Phil's letter a few pages ago, we impacted 3,909,042 lives.

In these pages, we will report on our Year 3 progress. You'll see what we did well and what we did not do so well.

The men and women of the global Walk Thru the Bible family have worked faithfully and tirelessly toward the doubling goal, in spite of challenges and turmoil, shutdowns and danger. We did not plan for a pandemic, we did not plan for war in Ukraine, but we also could have never planned for what God has done!

The 7 Growth Strategies

A Progress Report at the end of Year 3

1 GLOBAL KIDS' MINISTRY YEAR 3 GOALS:

• Continue growth of the WTB kids' ministry in 3 existing regions (South Asia, West Africa, and Asia Pacific) and expand to 4 new regions (Central and South America, East Africa, Northern Eurasia) resulting in ministry impact of 1.3 million kids by June 30, 2022.

We continued the growth of our kids' ministry in the 3 existing regions and launched the WTB kids' ministry in 4 new regions—Central and South America, East Africa, and Northern Eurasia. As a result, we taught 1,287,552 kids our otLIVE and ntLIVE Bible overview events in FY2021-22.



Our global kids' gathering for our regional directors, children's coordinators, and U.S. leadership staff was held in Istanbul in April, 2022, to complete training in *otLIVE* and *ntLIVE*; to introduce follow-up materials (*otSTORIES*) for kids' instructors and teachers to use in their children's classes to continue the teaching of the big picture storyline of the Old Testament; to set goals for ministry expansion and impact; and to build relationships and community



- among the global teams.
- 2 TECHNOLOGY YEAR 3 GOALS:

- 10 languages resulting in 25,000 downloads by June 30, 2022.

The Walk Thru the Bible mobile application and the mobile application in 10 languages were both launched during this

• Launch the Walk Thru the Bible mobile application in

fiscal year. The app in 10 languages fully launched in mid-June, so we did not have enough download data to report yet. The mobile app is available in the following languages: Spanish, French, Arabic, Portuguese, Russian, Kazakh, Isi-Zulu, Mandarin, Hindi, and English.

• Create and distribute digital content at least 4 times per week across digital channels resulting in an average 10% response rate when a call to action exists with a 12,000-person impact.

Walk Thru the Bible continues to increase digital content creation and distribution across multiple channels, including our website, social media platforms, email, and podcasts. The total number of people impacted grew to 66,795 with more than 3,000 pieces of digital content downloaded; more than 800 podcast listeners (average); more than 11,500 people receiving a daily devotional email; more than 28,000 WTB blog readers; more than 18,300 video viewers; and more than 1,500 app installs. Our media strategy has resulted in more awareness of Walk Thru the Bible, increased engagement and following on our social media platforms, and many downloads of free resources from our website.

3 | PARTNERSHIPS YEAR 3 GOALS:

• Expand existing global partnerships and develop two new partnerships in each of the 10 regions by June 30, 2022, resulting in an 80,000-person impact through partnerships.

This initiative continues to grow, but we will not know the full extent of lives impacted until the regional directors have opportunities to train new instructors within these organizations. In each of the 10 regions, the WTB regional directors have formalized at least 2 partnerships with organizations that will expand Walk Thru the Bible's ministry reach through their channels. There have also been a number of smaller, informal partnerships established by our RDs for specific purposes. We are encouraged by the progress of this initiative so far.

• Distribute content piece to pastors 2 times per month through partnership channels resulting in an impact of 7,500 pastors.

Several of the main digital content pieces that helped meet the goal of this initiative include Jesus in the Old Testament, Bible Study Simplified, and Chosen: When God Calls Your Name ebook. These content pieces resulted in nearly 3,000 pastors impacted. While we did not meet the goal of 7,500 pastors downloading a content piece, we are encouraged by the progress made in this new-to-us way of serving pastors.

4 LIVE EVENTS YEAR 3 GOALS:

• Expand Phil's public presence as WTB's president through at least 20 public speaking engagements with at least 4 specifically to church leaders, speaking to a total audience of 10,000.

Even though a lot of speaking engagements were either cancelled or postponed at the beginning of the fiscal year due to COVID19, we had some success with booking events and having Phil speak at events. The total audience for his in-person speaking events during this fiscal year was 6,380 and the audience for virtual events where he was invited to speak was 7,987.

• Develop comprehensive lead generation strategy resulting in 75 churches per quarter requesting information about hosting a live event.

With churches slowly opening up during the first quarter of our fiscal year, our strategy was multi-faceted: We still marketed to pastors, churches, and Christian schools, but we also formed new partnerships with a few denominational associations that are beginning to bear fruit. We also focused on some new marketing channels and tactics, and we continued with sales calls and email campaigns to pastors. Live events are beginning to pick up now that churches are open and back to some normalcy in attendance, and we had an average of 50 churches per quarter requesting information about hosting a live event.

5 CONTENT CREATION AND DISTRIBUTION YEAR 3 GOALS:

• Produce 2 courses in the Biblical Character Series, one available by December 1, 2021 which sells 400 products in FY2022 and the second available by April 1, 2022 which sells 200 products in FY2022.

Rescue: Leading Yourself and Others to Freedom (life of Moses) launched in March, 2022, in the U.S. As of June 30, 2022, 145 products have been sold in the U.S. Many pastors in several of our global regions have been trained and have taught this course to their congregations. The second course, Catalyst:

Helping Others Pursue Their Purpose (life of Barnabas) has been filmed and produced, and will be ready for release at the end of September, 2022.

• Develop and produce new small group course that accomplishes the same outcomes as *otLIVE*, ready for broad distribution by the end of FY2022.

Due to a few delays (for example, Israel was closed to visitors for a while) the filming of this new course, called ot-PANORAMIC, was held in May, 2022. 6 | PASTOR INSTI-TUTE TRAINING YEAR 3 GOALS:

• Expand our pastor institute to 8 regions in which 200 pastors are trained in each region who teach at least 100 people in FY2022.

The pastor institute training is now in 8 of our 10 regions. This fiscal year, 6,229 pastors were enrolled in and trained in our pastor institute training model across those 8 regions. Many of these pastors

were trained in the complete Biblical Character Series.

7 PERSECUTED CHURCH YEAR 3 GOALS:

• Repurpose Biblical Character Series course and film in Arabic to distribute to at least 25,000 persecuted believers through media partner.

Hussam Fakhoury, Lead WTB Teacher/Trainer for the MENA region, translated into Arabic, taught, and filmed Refuge: Finding Home in a World of Change (life of Ruth). The course will launch at the end of September, 2022, and will be carefully distributed to persecuted believers throughout the region.

• Expand ministry in MENA region by training at least 10 instructors from 8 countries and ensure that each instructor teaches 3 events in FY2022.

Nearly 3,500 new otLIVE/ntLIVE instructors were trained in this region in FY2022.

That's **99.67%** of the doubling goal, and a **59% increase** over last year's lives-impacted number.



Three years ago, Walk Thru launched a 3-year vision to double ministry impact. As you've read in these pages, in FY2021-22—the final year of the vision—more than 3.9 million people encountered the Word of God through Walk Thru the Bible's live events and biblical resources. More than 23,600 pastors and Bible teachers were trained in Walk Thru's courses and events. Nearly 1.3 million children were taught the big picture story of Scripture,

learning that they have a heavenly Father who loves them and wants to have a relationship with them. Nearly 2.6 million adults either attended a Walk Thru the Bible live event or consumed a Walk Thru the Bible digital resource.

God has given us the great privilege and responsibility to minister to people in 141 countries around the world.
